


Hurricane Preparedness 2024

2024 Hurricane Season is set unprecedented season. As of the end of April, we have already had one disturbance in the Atlantic and are predicted to have 24 named storms, 11 of which will

become Hurricanes and 6 are projected to be a Category 3 or stronger. This is well over the average of 14 named storms, 7 Hurricanes, and 3 major Hurricanes in a given season.
